

Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Economics Study Guide

General Information

The Department of Economics operates from the academic year 2022 - 2023 the M.Sc. in “Economics” with two (2) specializations: “Econometrics and Data Analysis” and “Economic Analysis and Policy”.

Goal

The M.Sc. in “Economics” aims at providing high quality postgraduate education in economics. Its purpose is to train scientists capable of responding to the changing needs of the labor market and the economy in general, as well as to contribute, through research and specialization, to the advancement of economics.

Admissions and Duration

For the M.Sc. program, a Bachelor’s degree is required. The duration of the program is 3 academic semesters.

Curriculum

The eight (8) core and six (6) elective modules of the program are taught in the 1st and 2nd semester, respectively. During the 3rd semester, students write their dissertation. The MSc program corresponds to 90 ECTS credits.

Number of Students Admitted

The maximum number of admitted students per academic year is thirty (30).

Academic Staff

Faculty members of the Department of Economics and other Departments of the University of Ioannina or other domestic or foreign Universities are employed, as well as other categories of teaching staff.
